## SECURITY SHIFT MANAGER – FULL TIME

Main responsibilities and duties include:

- Monitoring all aspects of the casino operation.
- Recording and reporting any irregular or illegal activities that occur in the casino.
- Preparing detailed incident and investigative reports in a clear and precise manner.
- Ensuring all Surveillance & company policies, work rules and procedures are strictly complied with at all times.
- Maintaining strict confidentiality in all matters pertaining to equipment, procedures and information.

To be considered for this position you will have:

- Minimum of 2 years Casino Surveillance experience.
- Ability to work in a close team environment.
- Proficient in written and spoken English.
- Available to work a rotating roster including days, nights and weekends.
